
Key Vocabulary A compass has four main directions, which The are north, east, south and west. Part of the Compass compass (the needle) will always point north. You then have to work out which direction you are facing depending on where north is. A special tool that helps you know which compass direction you are facing. It could be something made by people (a human feature) or something that occurred naturally (a physical feature). Big Ben is a landmark in London.


