Urban	Towns and cities.
rural	Countryside or farmland.
Types of Farming	Farming, also known as agriculture, is the growing and harvesting of crops or raising of livestock.
mixed	more than one type of farming Areas of the United Kingdom- central areas
dairy and cattle	when cows are usually kept for their milk Areas of the United Kingdom - warm and wet areas where the grass is more suited for grazing
hill	rearing of sheep for food and wool Areas of the United Kingdom - rocky and hilly areas where it is harder to grow crops because of the cooler weather
pastoral	rearing of animals including sheep and cattle Areas of the United Kingdom - western areas where the land is steeper and conditions are more wet and windy
arable	growing of crops such as vegetables and cereals Areas of the United Kingdom - eastern areas due to flat land, rich soil and warmer weather conditions
aquaculture	areas where fish and seafood are farmed Areas of the United Kingdom - both in seas and freshwater sources
Fascinating Fact More than two-thirds of the land in the UK is used for agriculture.

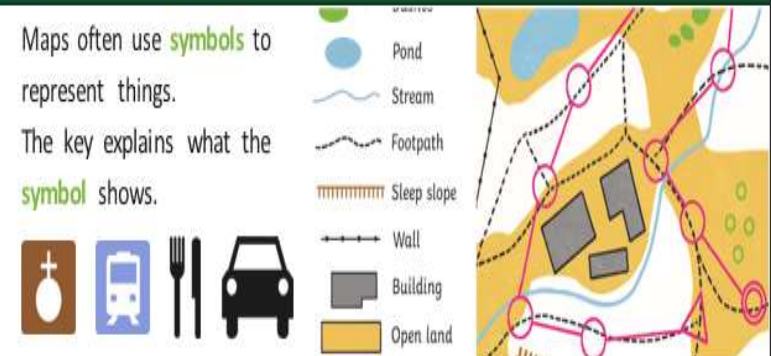
